#### DATA TIMEFRAME

- Heart Attack, Heart Failure, and Pneumonia Care: October 2007 through September 2008.
- Heart Bypass Surgery: Mortality rates are from calendar years 2005 and 2006
- Patient Safety: Surgical Care Quality Improvement (SCIP), January through September 2008; Hospital-Acquired Pressure Ulcers, January through December 2008.
